Prenatal Webinars

Postpartum Telephonic Support

A trusted nurse and health coach will work with you to answer your questions and provide guidance during scheduled postpartum telephonic sessions.

Lactation Support and Resources

We will provide information on OSU Health plan lactation benefits, chest/breast feeding tips and lactation support.

Postpartum Home Visit

Birthing people living in Franklin and contiguous counties are eligible for a complimentary home visit by a registered nurse from Interim HealthCare within four to ten days of discharge to check on you and baby.
